



Inpatient Alcohol & Substance Abuse Rider

The following rider is an addendum to the "Subscriber Contract" which provides for the provision of all basic health services.

Benefits

The "Benefits" section of the Subscriber Contract is amended as follows:

Inpatient Alcohol/Substance Abuse

This rider provides coverage for the diagnosis and treatment of alcoholism and alcohol abuse and substance abuse and substance dependence. The rehabilitation services must be received in a hospital based or free standing facilities in New York State that are certified by OASAS, and in other states to those which are accredited by the joint commission on accreditation of hospitals as alcoholism, substance abuse or chemical dependence treatment programs.

Co-payments

Inpatient admissions may be subject to a co-payment per continuous confinement. Please see the subscriber contract "Summary of Benefits" to determine if an admission co-payment is applicable to inpatient services.

Limitations and Exclusions

All of the terms, conditions and limitations of your Easy Choice Health Plan Group Subscriber Contract and Summary of Benefits to which this rider is attached also apply to this Rider, except where specifically changed by this Rider.

Nothing in this rider shall be construed to prevent the medical management or utilization review of mental health benefits, including the use of prospective, concurrent or retrospective utilization review, preauthorization, and appropriateness criteria as to the level and intensity of treatment applicable to behavioral health.

Nothing in this rider shall be construed to prevent a policy from providing services through a network of participating providers who shall meet certain requirements for participation, including provider credentialing.
